- **Entries close 12 noon Friday 26th March 2010.**
- **LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**
- **Exhibition room will be open 10am till 1.45pm on Saturday 27th March for staging of exhibits.**
- Exhibitors will stage their exhibits under the direction of the stewards.
- Exhibition room will be closed from 2pm Saturday 27th March 2010 for judging.
- Exhibition room will be open to the public 9am till 3.30pm Sunday 28th March 2010.
- Where there is only one entry in a class, the prize will be at the discretion of the judge. Should only two exhibits be shown in any one class, no second prize will be awarded, unless in the opinion of the judge such exhibit could have gained a prize had there been further competition.
- Every exhibit must be grown by or be the work of the exhibitor.
- No entry will be accepted if it has previously won a prize at CapelFest.
- All entries must be made on CapelFest form of entry and be accompanied by entry fees.
- The committee reserves the right of refusing or canceling any entry without giving reason for doing so.
- The judges decision is final.
- Every reasonable care must be taken of exhibits but no responsibility will be incurred by CapelFest.

- **PRIZE MONEY MUST BE COLLECTED from the Secretaries desk, exhibition room Sunday 28th March after 9am. Claim Ticket and Receipt of Entry must be produced on collection.**
- The Exhibition rooms will be cleared of all people, expect stewards, at 3.30pm on Sunday 28th March, re-opening at 3.45pm to 5pm for removal of exhibits. Re-entry will be by Receipt of Entry only.
- **ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE COLLECTED between 3.45pm and 5pm on Sunday 28th March at the conclusion of CapelFest. Receipt of Entry required for collection.**
